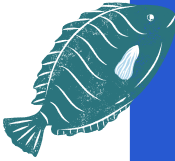

Pirates Lost at Sea - Talewise Production Monday June 27 at 6:30 pm

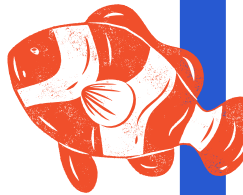
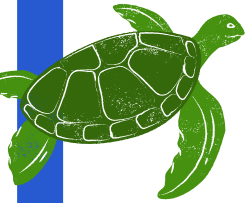
